Minutes of a meeting of the Licensing Committee held on Friday 13th March 2020 at 14:30 in Office 2, Clayport library building, 8 Millennium Pl, DH1 1WA.

1. TO RECEIVE ANY APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Cllrs R Cornwell and D Freeman.

2. TO RECEIVE ANY DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST FROM MEMBERS

None received.

3. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

None received.

4. TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE LAST LICENSING COMMITTEE, HELD ON 14th FEBRUARY 2020

The Minutes of the meeting held on 14th February 2020 were unanimously agreed as a true and accurate record of proceedings.

5. DISCUSSION ON TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICES

Members were unclear as to the reasoning behind Durham Police's decision not to object to the Temporary Event Notice application for Durham Students' Union's showing of the recent Tyson Fury fight when an objection was submitted in relation to the same such event at Player's Bar in Durham City.

It was **agreed** that the Clerk should write to the Licensing Team at Durham County Council to request that the Parish Council be updated on any new Temporary Event Notice applications in the parish area as an interim measure. It was also **agreed** that the Clerk should also write to the relevant Minister requesting that Parish Councils also be made formal consultees on any new such applications. At present, only the Police and Environmental Health are consulted on these applications.

6. UPDATE ON RECENT LICENSING APPLICATIONS

The Chair reminded Members that the application for Jovial Technologies Ltd had been withdrawn completed. The Chair also reminded Members that the applications from both John Snow College and South College had been amended according to the Parish Council's objection letters.

The Clerk advised that he had not yet received a date for a hearing on the Curious Mr Fox application, however Committee Members agreed to maintain their objection to this application in spite of recent correspondence from the applicant's barrister.

7. TO CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING LICENSING APPLICATIONS.

Elsa Kent (Durfest) – New premises license application

It was agreed to object to this application on the grounds of causing a public nuisance. In the objection letter it will be requested that the application be amended so that the playing of live and recorded music ceases at 11pm and that the serving of alcohol ceases at midnight.

There being no further business, the Chair thanked members for their attendance and closed the meeting.
