The Chair advised Members that the Brewdog application had been granted following its hearing on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021. The Chair advised that this application was granted with the following conditions:

1. The mobile phone number of the DPS is to be available to the Parish Council and Residents' Association so that they can be contacted.
2. At the request of the Residents' Association or Parish Council, a meeting is to be arranged by Brewdog to discuss any issues that may arise.

The Clerk reported that the objection letter to the Lane 7 application is currently being drafted and will be circulated to Members in due course for approval.

The Clerk also reported that the representative from Fat Hippo is wishing to speak with the Parish Council's Licensing Committee at its next meeting of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021 in order to go over its remaining concerns about the application; namely the use of Deliveroo and the public safety implications of further vehicle movements on Saddler Street.

The Clerk also reported that the application for Babylon had been granted by DCC, with the Parish Council's objection having been rejected.

## **6. Consideration of the following new licensing application(s):**

Belle Leisure Ltd - Jimmy Allen's 19-21 Elvet Bridge Durham DH1 3AA – minor variation to a license application.

It was **agreed** to object to this application on the grounds of prevention of crime and disorder.
